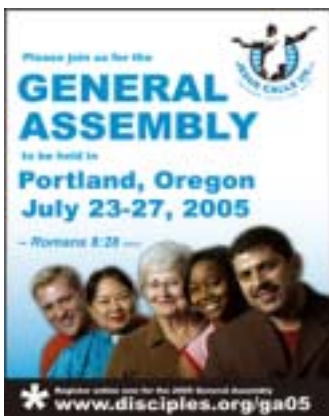

## Disciples' Faithfulness Abounds

Friday, February 12, A.D. 2005

Congregations, members and friends of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) have now given **more than \$1.1 million through Week of Compassion** to support relief and recovery efforts in the aftermath of the Indian Ocean earthquake and tsunami that killed an estimated 250,000 people and seriously impacted more than 5 million others. Indeed, the humanitarian crisis following the December 26 tsunami has evoked a remarkable spirit of generosity, concern and awareness throughout the whole church. This offering represents an unprecedented response to a disaster in WOC's 60+ year history.

But even more remarkable are the ministries of help and hope we are supporting through our church partners in the region, who continue to work tirelessly on behalf of thousands of tsunami survivors. Disciples' strong partnerships with local Asian churches and our active and historic relationships with ecumenical partners like [Church World Service](#) and [Action by Churches Together](#) have enabled us to be present in these countries, even before the tsunami struck, and will enable us to continue serving there long after the world's attention has turned elsewhere.

This surge of sharing from our congregations, members and friends is enabling WOC to provide significant support to current relief efforts and will ensure that we accompany the survivors down the long road of recovery and rehabilitation.

**On behalf of the Week of Compassion Committee, who is charged with the stewardship of these gifts; our church partners, who are turning them into instruments of help and hope; and the survivors, who are slowly but surely putting their lives and communities back together — thank you.**
